WHAT IS A LONG TERM CARE OMBUDSMAN?

A Long Term Care Ombudsman is a dedicated advocate for residents of long term care facilities. Ombudsmen listen to concerns, resolve problems, and ensure that every resident is treated with dignity and respect—especially during times of crisis, like facility closures. When residents are displaced, the Ombudsman Program steps in to help them transition safely and compassionately to new homes.

WHY WE RUN

This year 12 long term care facilities have closed across South Carolina, leaving many residents suddenly without a place to call home. Your participation will help provide:

- Relocation Bags: Sturdy, new bags for dignified moves
- Activity Items: Puzzles, books, and games to ease loneliness
- Clothing: Pajamas, sweatsuits, and essentials for comfort
- Toiletries: Hygiene products for immediate needs
- Care/Comfort Items: Cups, journals, calendars, and more
- HOPE: Most importantly, your support shows displaced residents they are not forgotten
