Track and Field; Registered with the Palmetto Grand Prix.** Race headquarters will be at the Gazebo in front of the magistrate office on Congress Street. 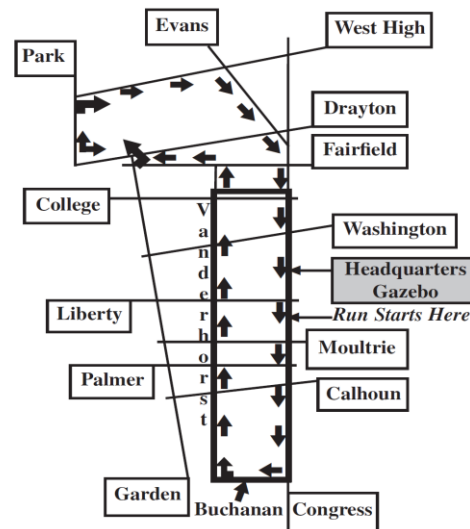
