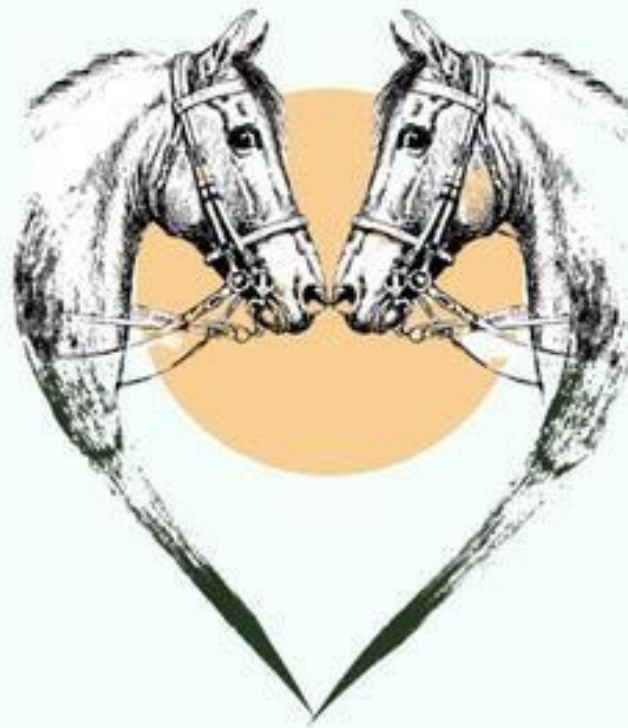

Event Description

The Bridal Trail is nominally a 3.1 mile course around the 100- acre Twelve Oak Estate in Lexington County. It is intended as a Cross-Country course for any runner who enjoys running on uneven terrain. Deer and Turkeys have been seen in the woods, but none are anticipated on race day.

The event will have a DJ for entertainment, a few outdoor games, food trucks and adult beverages as well as some of the more customary post-race fare.

The race will begin and end in front of the Hangar. It was originally an airplane hangar. It is now an event space for parties and weddings.

Runners will be visible for a quarter-mile on the first lap, a half-mile on the 2nd lap and a quarter-mile at the finish. We expect runners to bring their support group who will watch them set their own course-record.

T-shirts and finishers' awards will go to all registered entrants. Age group awards will go to the first three places in 5-year age groups from 11-years old thru 75 plus. Overall winners will also receive special awards and a course record. Awards to Masters, Grand Masters and Senior Masters will be presented, if the number of registered runners in each group is large enough to merit the award. We expect this to be one big party to kick off the summer. Come out and have some fun. Dancing is encouraged.

Course Description

The Bridal Trail 5K is a two lap course around Twelve Oak Estate in Lexington County. The course is a recently cleared dirt and grass path through part of a 100-year old forest. Along the route you will see some abandoned buildings and a small stream.

Slight elevations in the terrain occur at random; roots, ruts, dips, and deviations in the surface will be present. The total elevation change is only 36 ft falling during the first part of each loop and rising during the 2nd part of each loop. The 1/2 mile at the front of the property is essentially flat grass. It was previously a pasture; hence, the equine theme.

Please be careful. The weather will be hot, the course will be coarse. We do not recommend the course for children, or inexperienced runners. However, there will be plenty of parking, plenty of room for spectators to cheer, plenty of food and drink.
